**FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL IS TOMORROW!** Well, for all but Pre-Kindergarten (they start next Tuesday, September 7) and we have opening Assembly on the Astro-turf outside at 8:30 a.m. Parents are welcome to attend (bring your own chair if you need to). First Day of school reminders:

- <u>Drop off</u> procedure is in the handbook but remember to line up on Portal way but do not block driveways or park on the other side of the street from the school. There will be parking open next to the office building if you can't find a spot in front of the school
- Be sure to have all your <u>enrollment paperwork</u> completed by tomorrow after logging in on the website (<u>www.pcsnw.org</u>), go to the Enrolled Families Resource tab and make sure you filled in all the forms there.
- <u>Tuition</u> can be broken up into 10 monthly payments August to May so either you paid August 1<sup>st</sup> or you will need to pay on June 1<sup>st</sup> in order to make the 10 payments. September payment is due tomorrow.
- If you are <u>volunteering in the classroom</u> and working with students, you will need to provide a Covid Vaccine card or a religious/medical exemption request. Copies of the request are available in the office. If you are volunteering outside and/or not with children you don't need a card or exemption.
- We have an excess of pencils (donated to us) come to the office and snag some for home! While supplies last.
