- Writing on walls, playing with cleaning supplies, making a purposeful mess is not allowed
- Taking care of playground equipment and classroom items is important to do

I am a parent of 5...now ranging from 9 to 22 years old...and though I might think they are cherubs – I need to remember that they might break rules or cause problems from time to time and when they are young, I have the opportunity as a parent to give advice and help my kids to grow into caring, considerate, and responsible young women and men. These issues happen in every school and later on in the work place...so please work alongside me in *“training up children in the way they should go, so when they are older, they will not depart from it.”* (Paraphrased from Proverbs 22:6)
