I was touched by some of the Zoom class discussions and how people are helping people who were forced out of homes or needing help. Prayers are so needed during this state of emergency in Whatcom County.

**Modified Plan for Parent Teacher Conferences** - With the flooding and the reality of how that affected everyone differently, we are going to do our best to meet with you via Zoom (today/tomorrow) or after school next week (praying that we are back on-site and good to go for the three days before Thanksgiving).

**Popcorn Fundraiser** – with the school closures, we are able to still **receive orders on Monday (11/22) – first thing in the morning.** The popcorn will still be ready to pick up on Wednesday, November 24. Here's hoping we sold 400 bags...free ice cream for each student if we reach that goal! Let's do it!

**Operation Christmas Child** – with the school closures, we are going to be pushing the deadline and receive **boxes with labels & payment first thing on Monday morning (11/22).** If you want to drop your box off during other collection times: Thursday (11/18) 12-2, Friday (11/19) 2-4, Saturday (11/20) 11-2, Sunday (11/21) 2-4, and Monday (11/22) 9-11. If school is on, we will do a "shoebox picture" around 8:30 a.m. and then some staff will deliver the boxes to the depot after that. The place that we are dropping them off (or you can drop them off at) is: Immanuel Bible Church – 2000 W North Street, Bellingham (down the street from Yeagers).



We are planning to have our Christmas Program on Wednesday or Thursday (12/15 or 12/16) after supper at a local church. Please keep those evenings open as all students are participating and we would love to fellowship together – celebrating Christ's birth as a community. Stay tuned for more details!
