Clean surfaces, sanitized bathrooms, supervised children...all things that we hope for and maybe even expect at PCSNW. We continue to seek people to help in these areas – preferably weekly/consistently. We are currently in need of: Monday classroom cleaner (every other week), Thursday classroom cleaner (weekly), Wednesday & Thursday AM Recess (9:40-10:05), Thursday Lunch Recess (12:15-12:50), Monday PM Recess (2:10-2:35) supervision. For the outside supervision – I put a cushion of 5



minutes before and after the actual supervision times...and if you need to put in more volunteer time to meet the requirements...we could use help with cleaning the office, outside areas, etc.

Re-Enrollment will be open starting March 15th, 2022. In order to secure spots for your child, you will need to fill out the Re-Enrollment paperwork and pay the Registration Fee (please don't do this before March 15th, as we have updates to paperwork still needing uploading).
