Last week I attended the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) Leadership Conference and wrote something for last week's newsletter but it didn't make the "print". Here it is:

It is amazing how a little time of connecting with Administrators from other schools and speakers addressing our current "issues" inspires the need for a discussion about the future of our school! From realizing that our model is based on an out-dated "common school" to recognizing that we need to be vastly different than the school we had when we were students...and models that supported schools we attended as students no longer apply to the schools we need for 21st century.

Matthew 9:16-17 talks about not putting new wine in old wineskins and it really speaks to how we can't put our children into an old system that was meant for a different time and circumstance. This is just a preliminary topic to think and pray about – it speaks to the need for us as the Providence Christian School NW community to talk together and perhaps point our school in a new direction. For us to be uncommon...for us to rally behind a common vision & mission of teaching our students how to grow in relationship with Christ, be Christ-like in word and deed, and be lights in our world once we graduate from PCSNW.
