Parents, here is a friendly reminder of our **school drop off and pick up** procedures. Please use the turn-around at the end of Portal Way to create a line of cars for both Drop Off and Pick Up. Our Volunteer Gate Monitor, Mrs. TeVelde will assist students from their cars to the fence at drop off and to the cars from the fence for pick up.
