

Samaritan's Purse OPERATION Christmas Child SHOEBOX

Hello PCSNW families, we are preparing for Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child again. This is a program that let's us share the gospel of Jesus Christ and gifts of love to a child that may not receive a gift without our donation. This project was started in 1993 and has delivered shoebox gifts to children in more than 150 countries. Collection week is Nov 14-21. We will collect our boxes at school and bring them to a local collection site.

Things to know to prepare.

- Your child will bring home "How to Pack a Shoebox" form. This form is a step-by-step form of...
 - Ideas to pack
 - How to pack
 - Donate \$10 to cover shipping and project costs
- Items to NOT Pack
 - Candy, Gum, Seeds, Food
 - Toothpaste, Liquids, Lotion, Aerosol Cans
 - o Damaged or Used Items, Medication or Vitamins
 - o Breakable Items or Glass



- **Return** the "How to Pack a Shoebox" form and \$ or receipt with your shoebox(es) or follow the on-line payment instructions "Follow Your Box Tracking" samaritanspurse.org. If you pay on line be sure to submit your paid receipt with your shoebox.
- Preprinted cardboard shoeboxes are available in the office, while supplies last. However, it is encouraged to use a **plastic container 13 x 7.5 x 4.7 inches** that does last longer for the child and is waterproof.
- Return your shoebox(es) to PCSNW by Thursday, November 17th so we can deliver all of our boxes to a collection site.

Thank you for your participation in this program. Families are certainly welcome to put together as many shoeboxes as they would like. If time is a challenge there are options of build a box on-line. Please remember that your shoebox gift will be an expression of God's love to a child.
