As shared in our tour and interview with all families over the past 2 years, we acknowledge that the students at PCSNW are not perfect. They make mistakes and poor choices as much as they shine their light and make good choices (like all kids). We as a staff encourage the good behavior – and try our best to correct and teach kids to stop poor behavior. That being said, we have seen an increase in students stealing items from classrooms and classmate’s lunches...we addressed this today to the whole school – but I would appreciate follow up at home – reminding kids that they should ask before taking something (and accept a “no” if given) and not be in any of the buildings/classes if no adult is present. I appreciate the support and prayers in this.

We also give a wee reminder to families to give guidance in packing snacks/lunches as kids need “good fuel” to make it through the day and a filled water bottle for each kiddo is helpful too (they can refill at school).

We are still working on making sure people follow our Student Drop Off & Pick Up procedures. All families should be in the car line-up when dropping off and picking up their child(ren).

Exceptions include:

2. If you are cleaning after school – please remember to supervise your child(ren) if cleaning after classes dismiss (they need to stay with you – not roam freely)

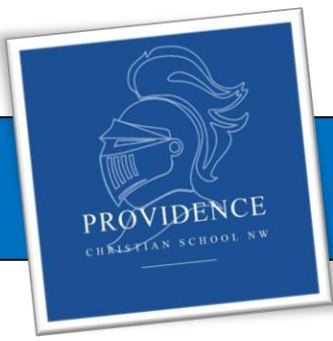
Remember:
