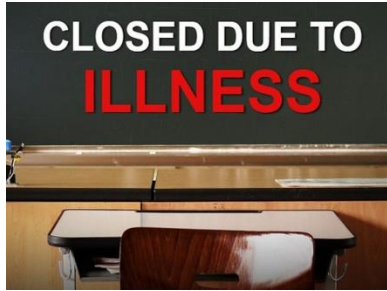


Wednesday Words
